




We had a Voter Education Seminar at both locations to educate our clients on the upcoming election. Area Agency on Aging hosted a discussion at both locations discussion Open Enrollment and the changes coming in 2025.

We have begun our annual Holiday Angel's Gift Drive for Christmas. This year the emphasis will be on providing gift cards for food. We recognize the cost of food continues to be high, and we are hopeful that we can bring some relief to our clients during the holiday season.

On the downside, last month saw us responding to two (2) hurricanes in a two (2) week period. We weathered the first (Helene) fairly well; however, the second one (Milton) proved quite damaging to our western and northern areas of the County. The worst area hit was the senior residential community of Spanish Lakes in Lakewood Park.

Our staff has been working with the State, County and other non-profit agencies to bring relief to those seniors affected. Let's keep all of them in our prayers.
